



NAVY AWIPS UPDATE Brian Strahl, JTWC

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- > MOA finalization, obligation of funds expected March 2016
- > AWIPS-II prototype to be fielded at FWC-N
 - Est delivery by August 2016, contingent on MOA/funding
 - IA testing and accreditation, user/admin training, forecast process development, etc
- Roll out of full system at FWC-N, FWC-SD, JTWC
 - FWC-N est Dec, FWC-SD and JTWC est January 2017
 - Dates contingent on NWS AWIPS contract award
- Initial JTWC implementation similar to current NHC configuration?
 - AWIPS primary for Data visualization, interrogation, fusion, *etc*
 - ATCF solely responsible for Storm management, TC forecast aids, warning suite production... Initial AWIPS delivery *cannot* replicate ATCF functionality

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ATCF is the cornerstone of JTWC operations and R2O

AWIPS expected to compliment ATCF with state of the art tools

Integration of ATCF into AWIPS-II is desirable end state, BUT...

- Integrated platform development requires coordination beyond JTWC
 - Management/funding decisions would occur at Navy Senior Leadership levels
 - ATCF used by FWC-N/FWC-SD to re-issue NHC warnings, SA, execute COOP
- What's the plan?
 - Development: Who's doing the work? What resources have been budgeted?
 - What is the expectation for USN share?
- > What is the development timeline?
 - JTWC cannot stall ATCF improvements and sustainment during transition, despite continued fiscally constrained environment
 - Real-time and annual support costs and contractor responsiveness?
 ATCF ~\$ 170K/yr vs. AWIPS ?
 - Future R&D transition focal point?

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
